I hope you are all well. There has been so much to celebrate this first term. I am encouraged by the many emails from parents who have identified adults who have been trying to sell in the locality. The police are now dealing with those reports. Furthermore, it is a credit to students at Fernwood who have also reported what they have seen. Please can I reinforce the need for parents to monitor *internet activity* and to ensure it is not accessible at bedtime. Mrs Gray, Head of Personal Development, has asked me to share the following information, plus a helpful website link:

"It is estimated that each year around 207,000 children in the UK start smoking, with almost 40% starting to smoke regularly before the age of 16. As a city, research suggests that we have higher than the national average levels of smoking. In response, as part of our Personal Development curriculum we have engaged in an evidence based smoking prevention programme, which works by first getting adolescents to engage with anti-smoking messages, then creating Personal Plans about how to refuse the offer of cigarettes, vapes etc.
